Question 1:

Question 2:

Compare and contrast the role, powers and responsibilities of a director with those of the shareholder and the company secretary.

Question 3:

You are requested to incorporate a company. Outline all necessary steps required to incorporate a private limited liability company, mentioning the key provisions to be included in the memorandum of association and the articles of association.

Question 4:

Describe the process of a voluntary winding-up and a court winding-up and highlight the differences between fraudulent trading and wrongful trading.
