# Question 1:

Describe and discuss the different types of risk assessments subject persons are expected to carry out.

### Question 2:

Provide a brief overview of Malta's Anti Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Legal and Regulatory regime with a particular focus on the obligations of subject persons.

## Question 3:

From a CDD perspective, analyse the status of a politically exposed person (PEP) including:

- i. Identifying who should be classified as a PEP or 'family member' or a 'close business associate';
- ii. Describing how PEPs are classified from a CDD perspective;
- iii. What measures are to be taken when dealing with PEPs.
