Question 1:

Question 2:

Hardly anyone would today refer to the Prime Minister as merely a primus inter pares. Discuss

Question 3:

a) Explain and describe the prerogatives of the President of Malta.

b) Explain the iter (journey) of a human rights action in Malta and before the European Court of Human Rights

Question 4:

Explain the right to fair hearing under Maltese constitutional law, illustrating your answer by reference to the jurisprudence of local courts and of the European Court of Human Rights.
