




Indian Comunity in Malta

- Malta served as one of the trading roots for exporting silk
- Indian immigration to Malta stopped 1952 and 1985





• 1800 to 1964 British Period





Malta... Recycling

- Starting 14 November
 - the scheme, which applies to:
 - water and flavoured water
 - carbonated and non-carbonated soft drinks
 - ciders, beers, and malt beverages
 - ready to drink coffee
 - flavoured alcoholic beverages with an alcoholic content level which does not exceed 5%
 - dilutables

Cans that are squashed or bottles that have their labels remove not be eligible for recycling.
