<p>Answer 3 (three) questions. Chosen questions have to be from different topics:</p> <p>Topic 1 Law of Persons</p> <p>a. <i>The legal implications of personal separation are several, both with respect to the minor children and the assets of the spouses. Discuss some of these legal implications.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>b. <i>Compare and discuss the salient elements which underpin the three matrimonial regimes under our Civil Law.</i></p> <p>Topic 2 Law of Succession</p> <p>a. <i>The Civil Code regulates thoroughly all the aspects relating to testate succession. Discuss the important features of testate succession.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>b. <i>The Civil Code creates a water-tight system to regulate intestate succession. Elaborate on the ways intestate succession operates under our Maltese Civil Code system.</i></p> <p>Topic 3 Law of Obligations</p>	

a. *Discuss the requirements of a valid contract and the factors which undermine contracts under Maltese law.*

b. *Indirect responsibility under Maltese Law can be the result of six specific instances. Discuss such instances with reference to legislation and case law.*

Topic 4 Law of Property

a. *Easements can be created by law or by man. Discuss the common easements which are created by the Civil Code, both with respect to law, and their applicability in case law.*

OR

b. *Community of property is a common occurrence. Discuss the salient features of community of property and the methods how such community can be terminated.*

Topic 5 Law of Guarantees

a. *Discuss the distinguishing features of Hypothecs and Privileges.*

b. *Discuss how ranking of hypothecs and privileges operate under the Maltese Civil Code system.*
