<b>Answer 1 (one) question.</b>	
<p><b>Question 1</b> "Schools are legally responsible for the safety of school children in their care. They should be. Our children are the future of our society. They are the most precious and valuable things on the planet. We must care for them 'carefully'. This is not only moral duty, but also a legal obligation." Ros Davis. Discuss this statement with particular reference to the duty of care owed to students as developed throughout the years both under local and foreign jurisdictions.</p> <p><b>Question 2</b> Teachers need always to be "free to inquire, to study and to evaluate, to gain new maturity and understanding." To what extent does this statement apply under Maltese Education Law?</p> <p><b>Question 3</b> "As a trainee teacher, I do not see how a government can improve behaviour in the classroom in the short term.
