## Task

The purpose of this unit is to develop an understanding of a particular topic you will write about which forms part of using evolutionary thinking for a healthier workplace.

## Note

The idea behind this presenttaion is that the student can use the knowledge gained through the sessions and apply their understanding of evolutionary principles and insights for healthier work environments that are built around people and their needs.

For **ANY ONE** topic from 1 - 3 below of your choice, prepare a short presentation of not more than 10 slides:

- 1. Background **description of the organisation** where this exercise will be conducted.
- A definition of the problem/issue/challenge e.g., low numbers of females in managerial
  positions; high incidence of reports of work-related stress; unsatisfactory performance by
  employees in certain departments; etc.
- 3. A brief reference to the **evolutionary knowledge** that is relevant for the topic and the problem chosen, also by explaining fundamental principles and theories.
- 4. A more detailed explanation about how you can **apply this knowledge to address these issues** and to register progress in the desired area.
- 5. Recommendations on specific **policies, systems, and business processes** that can be changed or introduced with the aim to have healthier workplaces for people.
- 6. A brief outline of the **benefits** of applying evolutionary thinking to the workplace and how evolutionary insights can translate into benefits for people and the organisation.

The presentation should be 10 minutes long and students will be expected to answer questions made by the students in class as well as the tutor. You are expected to use the Harvard referencing style.
