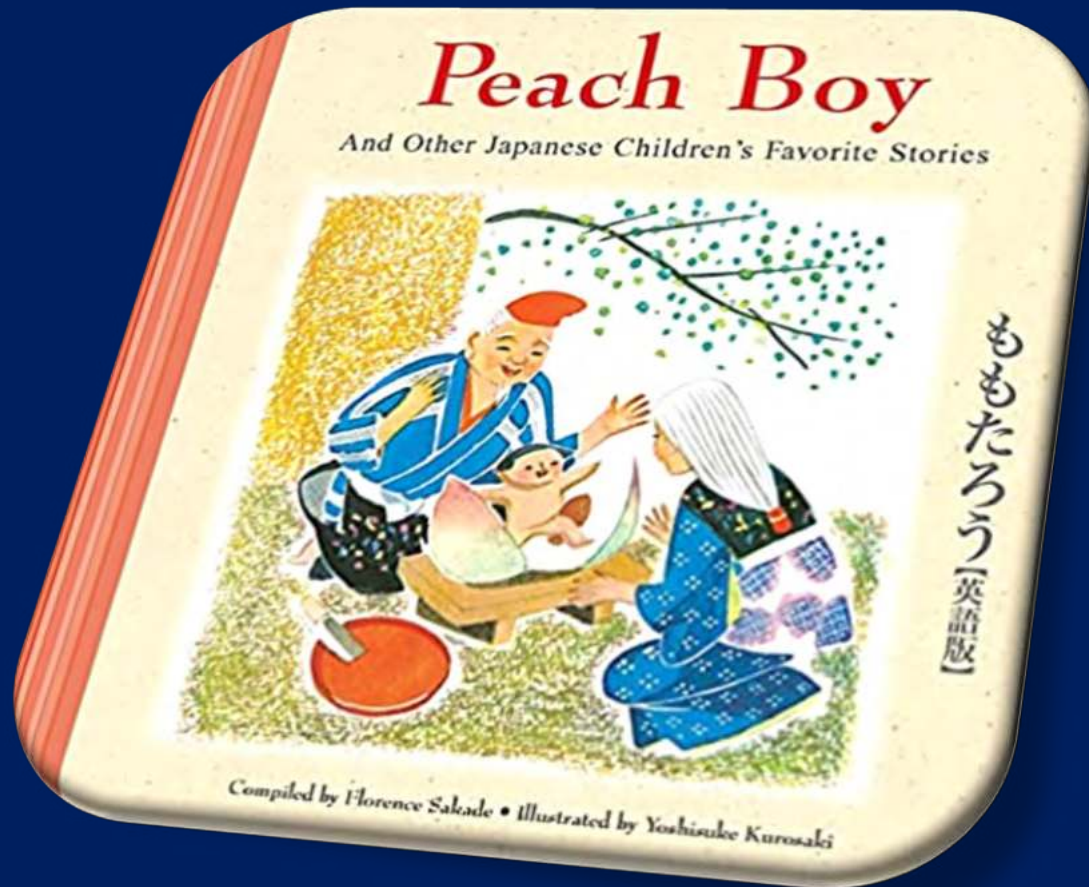

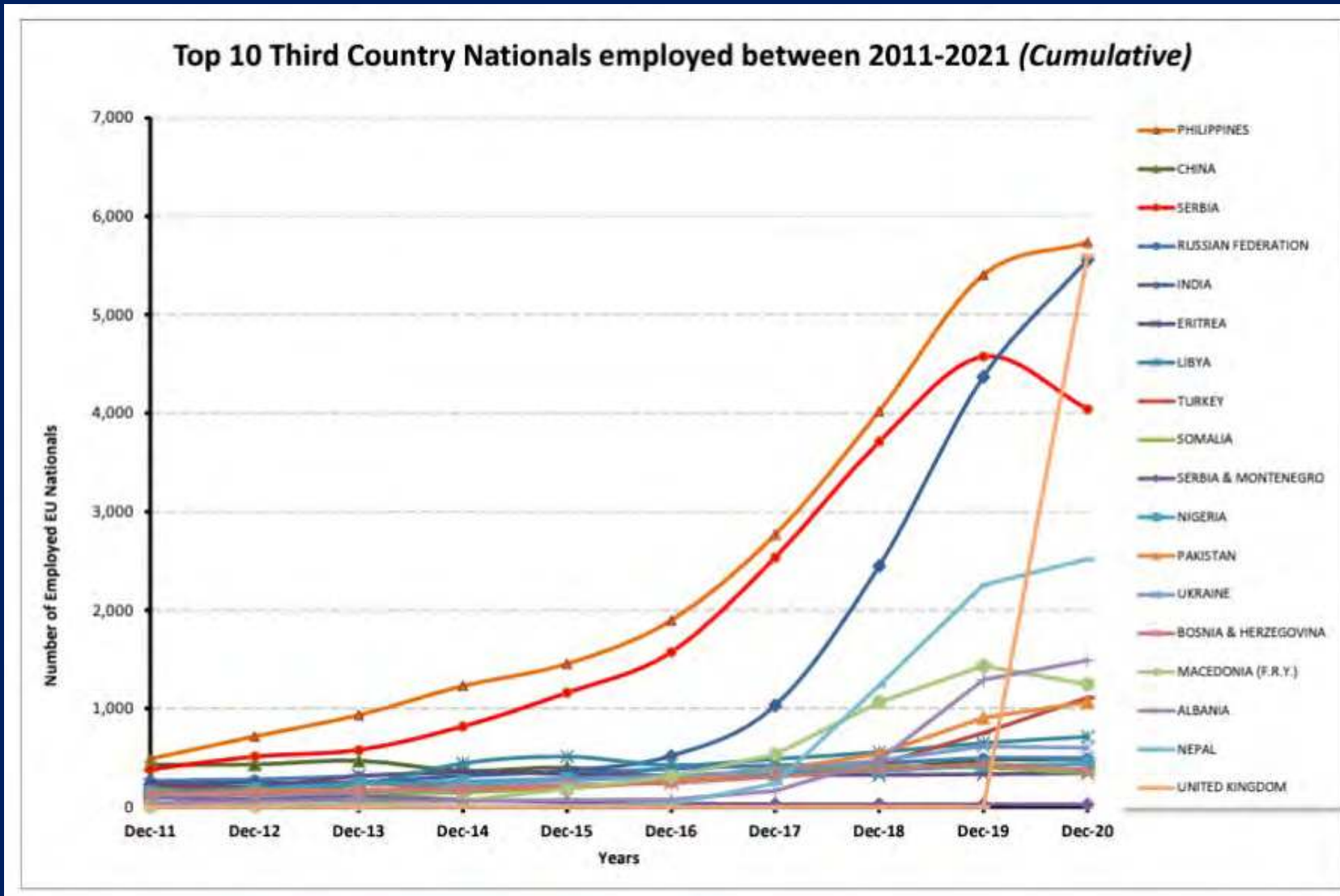


Indian Community in Malta

- Roots to migration starting around 1887 when Malta was under British colonial rule
- Malta served as one of the trading routes for exporting silk
- Indian immigration to Malta stopped 1952 and 1985

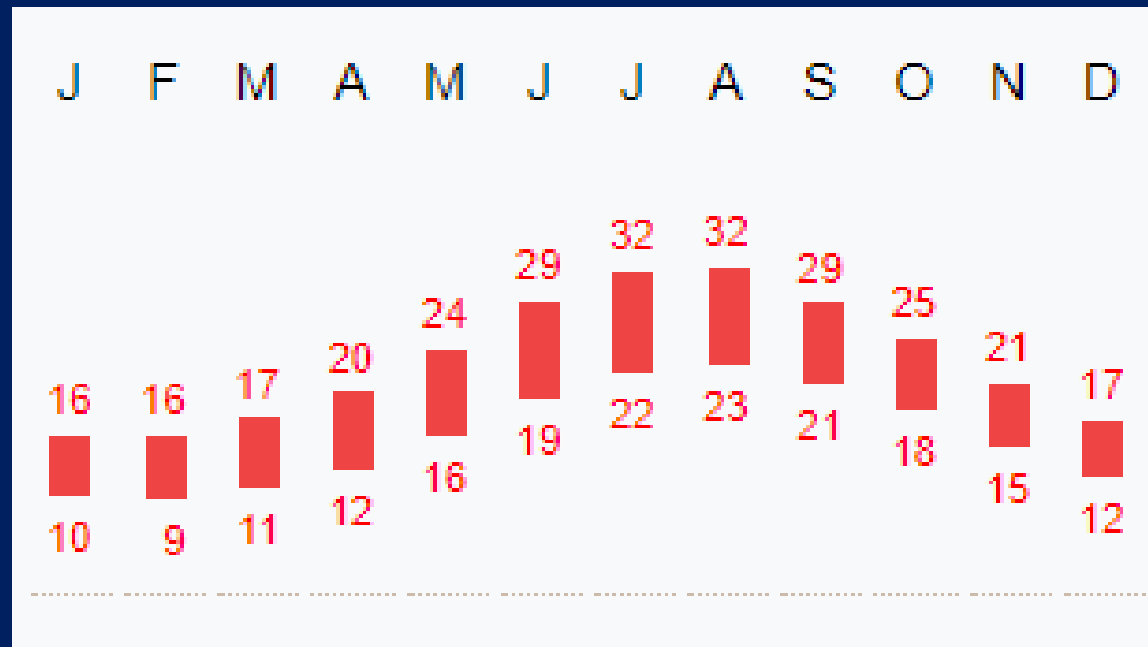

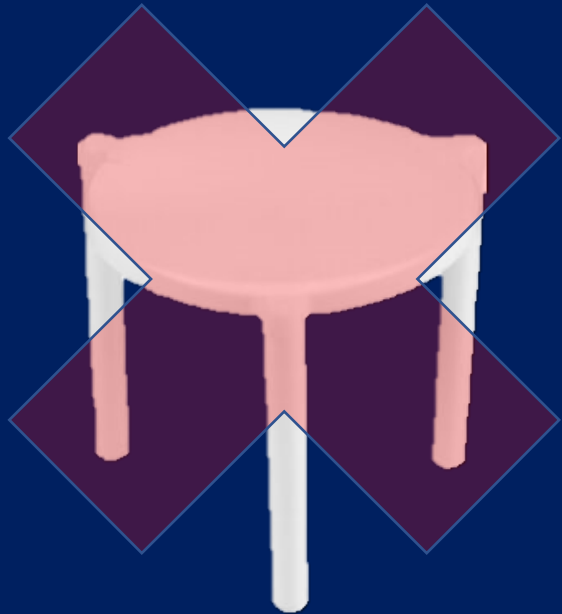

Malta... Prohibition of single use plastic



Malta... Recycling

Applies to:

- water and flavoured water
- carbonated and non-carbonated soft drinks
- ciders, beers, and malt beverages
- ready to drink coffee
- flavoured alcoholic beverages with an alcoholic content level which does not exceed 5%
- dilutables



Cans that are squashed or bottles that have their labels removed will not be eligible for recycling.
