#### Task

The purpose of this unit is to develop an understanding of a particular topic you will write about which forms part of Company Law.

## Choose and answer 2 questions from the following:

#### Question 1

A company in financial distress is typically faced with two main paths before it: liquidation and dissolution or alternatively, recovery and rescue. Discuss, making reference to recent legislative amendments.

### Question 2:

Corporate governance is principally concerned with the consequences of the separation of ownership and control. How this agency problem presents itself and how it is addressed is dependent on the pattern of shareholding. Discuss with focus on concentrated shareholding structures, including the notion of majority rule, minority rights and minority shareholder remedies under Maltese law.

## Question 3:

The Companies Act simply provides that the term 'director' incorporates "any person occupying the position of director of a company by whatever name he may be called, carrying out substantially the same functions in relation to the direction of the company as those carried out by a director". Discuss and distinguish between the different types of director.

### Question 4:

Describe the process for the incorporation of a company and the principal considerations to be made when preparing the constitutional documents of a company to be registered under Maltese law.
